

Young Aquatics Organisers Presenters Training

With all clubs crying out for volunteers, the asa have launched the Young Aquatics Organisers course. The award aims to develop volunteering and leadership skills in 14 – 18 year olds. The young volunteers may wish to be involved in the teaching, coaching administration or officiating aspect of aquatic activities. The award syllabus aims to achieve the following:

- Give young people an insight into the organisation of the asa and clubs that fall within its jurisdiction
- Equip candidates with the skills to help plan, deliver and evaluate the running of an aquatic event
- Give candidates the opportunity to volunteer within an asa accredited Swim 21 club
- Encourage candidates to develop their skills within aquatic sports

To support the delivery of this course the asa North East Region would like to train up some tutors, particularly in the Yorkshire and Humber area. The presenter's course takes candidates through the syllabus of the Young Aquatic Organisers course and ensures they feel confident delivering it to young people.
